DEAR STUDENTS,

If you are interested in medicine BAU International University, Batumi is the right place to receive high quality medical education through highly trained academic personnel, latest technologies, laboratories and classrooms. It is your door to successful medical career!



HOW TO APPLY?

Citizens of Georgia are enrolled at BAU International University, Batumi via Unified National Exams. Apart from exams in mandatory subjects students can take one of the following optional exams: Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Mathematics. The level of competences for 2017 academic year is 55%, except English Language. As the medium of instruction at BAU Batumi International University is English, Georgian applicants are required to take English Language Exam during the Unified National Exams. The minimum level of competences for 2017 academic year is 80%.

NB: This year, BAU International University, Batumi gives scholarships to support students who meet university requirements at Unified National Exams and successfully are enrolled at BAU Batumi according to current system and Georgian regulations.



HOW TO GET A SCHOLARSHIP?

In order to get a scholarship students have to accomplish the following procedures:

Register BAU International University, Batumi as a number one university in the priority list.

> Successfully pass the Unified National Exams; Receive minimum level of competences required from BAU Batumi.

After enrollment at BAU International University, Batumi scholarship certificates given to students will be in force.

NB: Students will be given the scholarship certificates after successfully passing a scholarship interview which will be placed before the Unified National Exams.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIRED

DOCUMENTS FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP?

Scholarships are competitive. Very small differences in candidates' backgrounds often make the difference. Grades are important, but extracurricular activities also matter because they show your varied interests and dedication to learning skills or providing service outside of the classroom

Thus, please prepare well and provide the following information to the e-mail address: admissions@bauinternational.edu.ge

CV with a photo including the student `s aims, targets, hobbies, skills in sports and arts;
At least 2 reference letters; One of them has to be written by his/her mentor teacher or guidance counselor from high school. The reference letters should include the contact information;
A letter of motivation explaining why the applicant wants to study Medicine. (minimum 300 words);
A document confirming that BAU Batumi is chosen as number one university in the priority list;

Any published articles, projects, book or patent that has published by the student;

Any diplomas or certificates received during some conferences or Olympiad.

Students should apply for the scholarship until April 30, 2017.

NB: Successful applicants will be asked for an interwiev in May. Exact dates will be announced on our facebook and web pages.
